Advance into Justice allows you to take up a rewarding second career within HM Prison & Probation Service, access great resettlement packages, employment benefits, training and progression opportunities. If you are interested in roles that are not included in the Advance into Justice scheme, please check out our Prison and Probation jobs website, which details all of our opportunities. As a Veteran, you may be eligible for the 'Great Place to work for Veterans' scheme, which provides a guaranteed interview to applicants who meet the minimum assessment criteria.

**UNCLAIMED PENSIONS** As part of the campaign to encourage Veterans with unclaimed pension benefits to come forward with their claims, the Forces Pension Society (FPS) encourages you to help identify anyone you think might qualify. We know there are thousands of Veterans who have not yet made their claims. A recent FPS Freedom of Information request showed that during the 24-month period alone, from Ist June 2020 to 31st May 2022, over 4,000 Armed Forces pensions went unclaimed. The AFPS Annual Report (July 2022) identified a larger total of 16,518 unclaimed benefits, with some Veterans having more than one entitlement.
