FIRESIDE CHATS Tonight's Fireside Chat will be a fascinating insight into life rowing boat across the Atlantic. Lieutenant Commander Hugo Mitchell-Heggs was part of the

Royal Navy four man 'HMS Oardacious' team that recently took part in the Talisker race. The team became the fastest military team in history to row the 3000 miles across the Atlantic in an astonishing 37 days. Next week's chat (TBC) will be given by Vice-Admiral Mike Gretton who will cover the first WWII Tonnage War and in particular, Convoy ONS-5, which was hounded and attacked by between 40 and 60 German U-Boats during the crossing from Liverpool to Halifax in April/May 1943.
