

cover the first WWII Tonnage War and in particular, Convoy ONS-5, which was hounded and attacked by between 40 and 60 German U-Boats during the crossing from Liverpool to Halifax in April/May 1943. The image shows the disposition of the ONS-5 ships in the convoy and those sunk (picture credit Joshua Smith – Academia).
